How to read Z-tests:

The Z-test is used to compare two percentage scores to see if the difference between them is “statistically significant”. For each row in a table it compares the break percent for each column with all other columns. Where multiple variables are used as cross-breaks in the table, the comparison will be among columns for the same variable only. E.g. in the tables, the columns within the “Gender” variable will only be compared with the other columns for “Gender”.

The cells of the table will show a series of letters and hyphens which refer, in order, to the other columns within the variable.

There are three possible character types:

- A hyphen, indicating the difference between the two %s is not statistically significant.
- A lower case letter, indicating that the difference is statistically significant at the 95% level.
- An upper case letter, indicating that the difference is statistically significant at the 99% level.

For example, if the Age variable has 6 columns, the Z-Test output for a given cell in the column C – the 35-44 age group - might read:

Ab----

This indicates that the differences between this column and column A is significant at the 99% level (upper case A), the difference between this column and column B is significant at the 95% level (lower case b) but the differences between this column and the columns D,E,F are not significant (hyphens). There will always be at least one hyphen in the output as a column cannot be significantly different from itself.
